Description

For Familias installation on Linux and Debian distributions, the Windows emulator Wine should be installed. First open the terminal by Ctrl + Alt + t and follow the steps indicated below.

```
## Updating and upgrading the system
sudo apt-get update
sudo apt-get upgrade
```

Installing Wine

64 and 32 bit versions of Wine are available. If you want to check you system information first type the command:

lscpu

Next please choose the appropriate version of Wine. A complete guide for Wine installation is available in https://vitux.com/how-to-install-wine-on-ubuntu/.

```
sudo apt install wine64 #For 64 bits version
sudo apt install wine32 #For 32 bits version
```

Downloading and installing Familias

 $Download\ Familias,\ windows\ version,\ from\ https://familias.no/download.\ By\ default\ Familias\ will\ be\ downloaded\ to\ /home/user/downloads/.$

```
cd /home/user/Downloads/ #Or the path where the Famlias executable is. wine32 familias_v_3_2_8.exe #For 32 bits, please change the version of familias if it is required wine64 familias_v_3_2_8.exe #For 64 bits # Next only required if your system needs executing the installation as sudoer, # if it's not, please try to avoid using sudo with wine. sudo wine64 familias_v_3_2_8.exe
```

Executing Familias

After following the steps of the installation (as described in https://familias.no/download), a direct access is generated in /home/user/desktop

```
cd /home/user/desktop
./Familias3.desktop
```
